



CALL FOR APPLICATIONS- VISITING PROFESSORS-FELLOWS for 2026/27

The Academic School of the European Institute for Management and Finance calls for applications for Visiting Professors/Fellows for the academic year 2026/27 which aims at supporting and encouraging the incoming mobility of Professors, Senior Fellows, Fellows and Researchers, coming from local/foreign academic institutions, to work with resident faculty in teaching, training, research and knowledge transfer initiatives, involving resident local and international stakeholders.

The Call for Applications provides for the assignment of a grant to visiting faculty, researchers and academic practitioners, who are called to deliver educational activities (seminars, CPD training modules, teaching modules) and support specific research and engagement activities.

The position of Visiting Faculty will be offered to Professors, Senior Fellows, Fellows and Researchers who have affiliations with universities and/or public/private academic/research institutions and hold or have held positions equivalent to those of full Professor, Associate Professor, or Fellows / Researcher.

Visiting academics (Professors/Fellows), academic practitioners and researchers will be able to take on one of the following types of mobility programmes in the academic year 2026/27:

- Short-Term visit (1 week to 3 months) or full semester visit as Fellow/Senior Fellow/ Professor with a view to carry out the following activities:
 - teaching modules that are part of curriculum - programme of studies
 - delivering workshops, seminars, or professional training
 - delivering training and research workshops for faculty and research community
 - supporting research programmes including bidding.

Delivery of the above could involve face-to-face or online, block delivery /distributed learning methods.

Support- Remuneration

The Visiting Faculty will receive honorarium pay which will depend on their ranking and portfolio of activities (deliverables), duration of teaching, level of study, CPD-training, income generation. EIMF will extend support in planning traveling to and finding accommodation on the island; provide office space and access to research resources, plus seed research funding (subject to a proposal).

Eligibility

The Call for Applications is open to EEA (European Economic Area) - European Union nationals; applications must be submitted by **15 December 2023** to the Head of Academic School and include the following:

1. Curriculum Vitae of the applicant, with a cover letter [no more than 2 pages], which can highlight key academic credentials, roles and experience in research publications/monographs; teaching and professional training experience, research achievements and accolades, including successful bids for external funding.
2. The Agreed Plan (no more than 2 pages) mapping the teaching /research activities that will be carried out during the visit, as agreed in principle with resident faculty and/or Head of Research Committee, Professor Panikkos Poutziouris
